COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

October 2024

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In October, the Committee responded to over 1,300 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 26 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 67 new travel requests in October 2024 for travel beginning in October or later. One hundred and fifty-two employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of October.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in October through live and on-demand offerings. Five individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on October 16. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

To better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee, together with the Committee on House Administration and the Communications Standards Commission, issued Joint Guidance Regarding Leadership Races, available here. The Committee issued a Pink Sheet regarding Guidance for House Staff Assisting in the Presidential Transition, available here. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available here.

The Committee released no public statements in October 2024. Prior public statements are available here.

The Committee issued a summary of its activities for September 2024 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
