#### **COMMITTEE ON ETHICS**

#### September 2025

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In September, the Committee responded to over 2,300 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 34 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 128 new travel requests in September 2025 for travel beginning in September or later. Two hundred and sixty-one employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of September.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in September through live and on-demand offerings. Five individuals attended the in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on September 4. There were no live, in-person Ethics training at the request of offices.
