COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

June 2025

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In June, the Committee responded to over 1,400 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 30 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 119th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 195 new travel requests in June 2025 for travel beginning in June or later. One hundred and forty-seven employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of June.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in June through live and on-demand offerings. Eight individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on June 23. 34 individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training at the request of two offices. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

The Committee released no general advisories or pink sheets in June 2025. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available <u>here</u>.

The Committee released one public statement regarding The Establishment of a Working Group in June 2025.
