## **Committee Letters**

The Committee sent the following letters in October:

- October 1, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Miguel Cardona, Secretary, U.S. Department of Education, regarding states' compliance with policies derived from the *United States v. Fordice* decision and their impacts on Historically Black Universities and Colleges (HBCUs). This was a joint letter with Subcommittee in Higher Education and Workforce Investments Chair Wilson.
- October 6, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Xavier Becerra, Secretary, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the Honorable Marty Walsh, Secretary, U.S. Department of Labor, and the Honorable Janet Yellen, Secretary, U.S. Department of the Treasury, urging strong enforcement of the *Affordable Care Act's* requirements that ensure consumers have access to the full range of U.S. Food and Drug Administration approved contraceptives without any cost-sharing.
- October 14, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, requesting that GAO study the impact of health care offerings by state Farm Bureaus, health care sharing ministries, and other health care arrangements that are exempt from certain federal and state requirements for health insurance.
- October 15, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, requesting a GAO study on the implementation and enforcement of Title IX in Athletics at the collegiate level, focused on institutions' compliance with the Title IX Athletics requirements. This was a joint letter with Subcommittee on Civil Rights and Human Services Chair Bonamici.
