- On January 20, 2023 sent to all the standing and select committees of the House letter requesting that committees submit their budget requests for the 118th Congress to the Committee on House Administration by Monday, February 13, 2023.
- Approved registration of 72 Congressional Member Organizations (CMOs) for the 118th Congress.
- Approved request by 10 CMOs to become Eligible Congressional Member Organizations (ECMOs) for the 118th Congress including Republican Study Committee, Republican "Main Street" Caucus, Congressional Western Caucus, Asian Pacific American Caucus, Congressional Equality Caucus, Congressional Black Caucus, Congressional Hispanic Caucus, New Democrat Coalition, Democratic Women's Caucus, and the Sustainable Energy and Environment Caucus.
- Provided guidance to Member offices to ensure compliance with Members' Congressional Handbook regulations.
- Provided guidance to Committee offices to ensure compliance with the Committees' Congressional Handbook.

Communications Standards Commission

- Reviewed 608 requests for Advisory Opinions
- Provided guidance and advice to Member offices on the use of official congressional communications and other resources.
- Commission staff meetings:
 - o 1/27/2023 HIR/CAO/Office of the Clerk: The purpose of the meeting was to obtain a better understanding of the way data between HIR and the Clerk of the House translate within Remedy applications. This initiated from a request by the Commission to standardize the listing of committees as Majority/Minority to be rearchitected as Republican/Democrat. A data solution is ongoing between by HIR and the Clerk of the House. Also discussed was the ongoing project with the CAO to implement a public online complaint-intake portal for Communications Standards.
- The Communications Standards Commission did not organize and did not hold business meetings.

Member Services

- The offices of Speaker Kevin McCarthy, House Majority Leader Steve Scalise and House Administration Committee Chair Bryan Steil (R-Wis.) are conducting the series "Running an Effective Committee in the Majority." A total of 185 staffers have already taken part in seven briefings. The series kicked off on Jan. 24 and will run until Feb. 27. Topics include: "Investigations 101," "Working with House Counsel," "Informing America" and "Deposition Deep Dive, "Legislative Clerk Training," "Records Management," "Hearing Procedure," "Markups Procedure," "Communications" and "Working with Legislative Counsel."
- Launched Spring 2023 Congressional Internship Program for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities with 16 offices participating.

Oversight Activities

- Successfully partnered with the US Capitol Police and House Sergeant at Arms to reopen the House Office Buildings to full public access.
- Partnered with the House Sergeant at Arms to create guidance to allow for staff-led Saturday Capitol tours. Worked with partners across the Hill to agree upon reopening the Capitol Visitor Center for Saturday walk-up tours beginning in early March.
- Successfully partnered with the Clerk to expand the House Directory Cards to include a
 Miscellaneous section with contact information for key support entities and resources across
 the Hill.
- Successfully partnered with the Chief Administrative Officer to expand and standardize food service hours across the Hill, including the offer of late afternoon/early evening dinner options for Members and Staff when there are late night votes.
- Increased accountability for the irresponsible actions of the Select Committee on the January 6 Attack on the US Capitol and the National Archives that resulted in over 1,800 unredacted PII entries being made publicly available on docs.gov. Partnered with the Government Publishing Office to ensure that personal information was removed and that those individuals were made whole.
- Partnered with House Recording Studio team to utilize new camera angles on the House Floor to modernize the audiences' experience and increase Americans' opportunity to see their House of Representatives in action in new and inspiring ways.

- Collaborated with House Administration's Member Services and Communications team to craft a Field Hearing Guide for committees across the House.
- Organized and hosted an introductory and informational tour of campus for Chair Steil that included meeting the boots-on-the ground personnel that make the House work every day. Tour included all House Office Buildings and the Capitol, and was accompanied by representation from the Clerk, Chief Administrative Office, House Sergeant at Arms, US Capitol Police, and Architect of the Capitol.
- Officially scheduled reoccurring, monthly, bipartisan oversight meetings with entities in House Administration's jurisdiction and re-established key contacts within each entity to ensure clear, constant communication.
