

- Wednesday, January 10, 2018**—The Full Committee held a Markup on H.R. 219, To correct the Swan Lake hydroelectric project survey boundary and to provide for the conveyance of the remaining tract of land within the corrected survey boundary to the State of Alaska.
- Wednesday, January 10, 2018**—The Full Committee held a Markup on H.R. 801 To amend the National Trails System Act to designate the Route 66 National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.
- Wednesday, January 10, 2018**—The Full Committee held a Markup on H.R. 1220, To establish the Adams Memorial Commission to carry out the provisions of Public Law 107-62, and for other purposes.
- Wednesday, January 10, 2018**—The Full Committee held a Markup on H.R. 2711, To designate a National Memorial to Fallen Educators at the National Teachers Hall of Fame in Emporia, Kansas.
