- 1. Choose a Vendor

- 4. Draft opening and closing scripts and transition comments
- **5.** Game Day Prep: Plan staffing support and Member briefing materials
- 6. Decide how to handle questions and communicate the strategy to your team
- 7 Draft Poll Questions
- 8. Game Time: Ask participants to opt-in
- 9. Pull attendee information and tag it
- 10. Reach back out to interested constituents

MODERNIZATION SUBCOMMITTEE INITIATIVES

<u>Longworth Main Street</u> - The Committee on House Administration, CAO, and AOC have been working to refresh the basement floor of Longworth to create a central hub for Members and staff with services available.

<u>Staff Collaboration Space</u> - On the fourth floor of Cannon, a new staff collaboration space pilot has launched to give staff an additional meeting space.

Flag Track Portal - A new pilot program to help offices easily manage and track constituent flag requests. Flag Track was developed to make a more efficient process for managing flag requests in each congressional office.

<u>E-Discovery Software:</u> House Committees now have access to industry-standard discovery document management software, which makes teh time-consuming taks of reviewing and analyzing documents much more efficient.

The Subcommittee will be rolling out a number of exciting new initiatives in the coming weeks.
