COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

March 2025

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In March, the Committee responded to over 1,700 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 41 requests for formal advisory opinions.

The Committee held its organizational meeting on March 25, 2025. The Committee provided public notice and granted public access to this meeting. The Committee also adopted rules for the current Congress during that portion of the meeting that was open to the public.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 119th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 332 new travel requests in March 2025 for travel beginning in March or later. Two hundred and six employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of March.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in March through live and on-demand offerings. Thirteen individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on March 10. Five individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training at the request of one office. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available <u>here</u>.

As part of an effort to promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, on March 24, the Committee issued a Pink Sheet detailing the 2025 Outside Earned Income Limit and Salaries Triggering the Financial Disclosure Requirement and Post-Employment Restrictions, which can be found <u>here</u>. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available <u>here</u>.

Pursuant to Committee Rule 7, the Committee released one public statement regarding Representative Cory Mills in March 2025. The Statement of the Chair and Ranking Member regarding Rep. Mills is available <u>here</u>. Prior public statements are available <u>here</u>.
