The primary mission of the Judiciary Committee is to protect and strengthen the fundamental freedoms of the American people. Major Committee investigations during the 119th Congress include the following.

**Immigration Enforcement**

The Committee's investigation of the root causes of the Biden-Harris border crisis is ongoing. The Committee will consider legislative reforms to close immigration loopholes, disincentivize illegal immigration, fix the broken immigration system, and make our country safer.

**The Censorship-Industrial Complex**

The Committee continues to examine collusion and coordination by the Biden-Harris Administration with Big Tech and other entities to censor free speech. This work includes an examination of the risk that emerging technologies pose to the First Amendment and the effect of European censorship laws on free speech in the United States. This oversight will inform legislation before the Committee.

**Weaponized Law Enforcement**

The Committee is conducting oversight of federal law enforcement entities—including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, and others—with respect to the misuse of authorities and resources during the Biden-Harris Administration. This work includes but is not limited to an examination of various politically motivated investigations and prosecutions relating to President Trump. This oversight will inform legislative reforms.
