COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

August 2025

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In August, the Committee responded to over 2,234 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 27 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 119th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 276 new travel requests in August 2025 for travel beginning in August or later. Six hundred and fifty-three employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of August, the most ever during August.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in August through live and on-demand offerings. Four individuals attended the in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on August 11. There were no live, in-person Ethics training at the request of offices. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

The Committee released no general advisories or pink sheets in August 2025. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available <u>here</u>.

The Committee released a Notice of Public Participation regarding campaign activity, available here. Prior public statements are available here.
