The Democrat Politician Protection Act

What Democrats Propose

Creates a “one size fits all” federally mandated approach to increase voter registration.

Overwhelms local election officials and administrators by arbitrarily limiting their maintenance efforts of voter rolls.

Prescribes post election processes that would require prescriptive mandates for ballots and voting machines

Provides money for mandated voting machines and election practices.

Attempts to increase election security by federalizing changes to voting systems and machines.

Changes the FEC from a bipartisan commission to a partisan one led by a "speech czar."

Limits free speech for groups that wish to voice their opinions on legislation.

Creates a 6:1 match of small-donor campaign contributions using public funds.

What Voters Deserve

Assist and partner with States by providing support for increasing voter registration.

Allow states to maintain their own voter rolls in order to: a) process voters in a timely manner on election day; b) avoid unfunded mandates; c) manage voter lists to avoid voting irregularities

Let states conduct their own post-election audits and provide resources and expertise.

Authorize appropriations for state block grants to incentivize states to adopt NIST approved machines.

Increase election security by supporting states choosing methods and machines. Multiple points of entry are more secure than one system.

Reauthorize the FEC in its current bipartisan makeup.

Bring regulatory parity between traditional media platforms and online platforms.

Implement disclosure of small-dollar donations to campaigns.
